## Christian Education

It is again an honor and a delight to report that Christian Education is growing at Salem Lutheran Church. Here are some highlights that some have requested:

**CONFIRMATION**: This class designed for the instruction of those who are ready to become knowledgeable members of the congregation. The 2-year program teaches Church History, The Small Catechism (10 Commandments, Sacraments of the Church, Theology) and an understanding of faith and life as a Christian. Students must serve as acolytes, attend class and worship regularly, and participate in a yearly project. The class meets two Wednesdays a month from 6-7PM, and two Sundays a month from 11-12:30PM. See Pr. Nathan for details. Anyone near 7<sup>th</sup> or

8<sup>th</sup> grade may join when parents also believe their child is ready.

#### CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL:

As we look upon this New Year we can see so many great things for which we can prepare. As we look back, perhaps we see things, which could have been done differently. Change them. Make right that which is wrong, straight, that which is has been crooked. In 2014 we've all lost loved ones, but their memory is strong among us, and their presence is closest at the table of our Lord. The veil is thin, and the vale is no longer full of tears, for the Lord is present with us, and they with Him...and too they with us!
