HEALTHY MINUTE/SAFETY MINUTE

Summer is here and many will go camping and spend their days outdoors. Let's keep ourselves healthy and safe while enjoying Mother Nature.

Being outdoors doing activities comes with the risk of injuries. Make sure your up to date with your tetanus, you don't want to end up in the hospital due to a rusty nail!

When taking food camping, make sure it's packed in tight, waterproof containers and keep them in an insulated cooler; preventing spoiled food that makes you sick. Make sure to separate raw foods from cooked foods; preventing cross contamination.

Prevent temperature related illnesses such as hypothermia by putting a plastic cloth or mat under your bedding to stay warm. Make sure you have packed enough bedding. On the other side - prevent hypothermia. Keep hydrated by drinking non-alcoholic, sugar-free drinks like water throughout the hot day; don't wait until your thirsting for a drink.
